

BALTIMORE BLOOMS WORKSHOP SUPPLY LIST **

**Kit Fee: \$45 (Payable @ ECQ Guild Meeting or via Square/Prepayment Required)

The workshop kit includes all of the supplies necessary to make the quilt except batting and backing. *The strips of fabric in these kits are already prepared for ruching. Included items are: Baltimore Blooms Pattern, One 14" square of fabric for background, One 6" square of green fabric for leaves, 2 stems 13" long Prepared with steam -a-seam tape, One 1"x 40" red strip prepared for ruching, One 1"x 8" yellow strip prepared for ruching, Leaf template, Freezer paper 6"x6", 2 yards total of embroidery floss in dark green, light green and brown, a sample of YLI silk thread, One Jeana Kimball straw needle size 11, (5) 1" x 44" strips of red fabric cut on the straight of grain for roses, (5) 1" x 8" strips of yellow fabric cut on the straight of grain for roses, One or more dark-green scraps of fabric measuring at least 6" x 6" for leaves, Two or more medium-green scraps of fabric measuring at least 6" x 6" for leaves, One light-green scrap of fabric measuring at least 6" x 6" for leaves, Two medium-brown scraps of fabric measuring at least 6" x 6" for leaves, embroidery floss in various shades of green.*

Workshop Participants need to bring the following items:

- Ruler
- Paper and fabric scissors
- Embroidery scissors (optional)
- Basting needle (an embroidery needle works well)
- Appliqué needle (straw needles size 11, Foxglove Cottage recommended/1 needle is included in your workshop kit, but you may want more) *
- Embroidery needle
- black or navy silk thread (YLI 100 weight)*
- beige silk thread (YLI 100 weight)*
- cotton thread to match ruched rose
- cotton thread to match ruched rose center
- Basting thread (any thread that you want to get rid of)
- Marking pen (black Pigma® pen size 01 or 02 recommended)
- pencil
- Tweezers (optional)

Optional Item for consideration: Clover® bias tape maker ½"

Straw Needles (size 11), Black/Navy Silk Thread, Beige Silk Thread and Clover Bias Tape Makers will be available at our ECQ Guild Meeting for purchase after the lecture!
