## El Camino Quilters

## Color Weave

Colors - Blue, Purple or Aqua in a Tone on Tone, Print or Batik that read as one color.

You need two fabrics - a medium to medium-light and a dark in the same color family.

## Cutting Instructions

Cut (1) - $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 151 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Rectangle of your lighter and your darker fabric.

1. Sew the two rectangles together on the long side with a scant $1 / 4$ " seam. Press the seam open.
2. Lay the unit out as in Fig A with the dark fabric on top.
3. Clean trim the left edge of the unit if needed - no more than $1 / 8$ "
4. Cross-Cut the unit into strips in this order, as in Fig A. $31 / 2 " 11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \quad 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \quad 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} 11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \quad 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
5. Flip the $\mathbf{2}^{\text {nd }}, \mathbf{4}^{\text {th }}$ and $\mathbf{6}^{\text {th }}$ strips as in Fig B.
VIP - It does matter which strips you flip so they will match the other blocks.
6. Sew the strips together with a scant $1 / 4$ " seam matching the center seams.
7. Press all of the seams in the same direction. Either way is fine.
The unfinished block is $121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
