<u>Colors</u> – Pick two Colors for one block -Bright Hot Oranges, Reds or Yellows in a Tone on Tone, Print or Batik that read as one color.

**Background** – White on White Print or Solid.

## **Cutting Instructions**

From Color 1 and Color 2


(2) 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 5<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" rectangles
(2) 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" rectangles
(2) 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" square


Note: You can cut all the pieces for each color from 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 22" strips.

White - (4) 3½" squares (4) 2½" squares

- Draw a diagonal line on the back of all the 2½" white squares.
- Match a 2½" white square to the end of all four 2½" x 5½" color rectangles right sides together. Sew on the drawn lines in the same direction as in Fig A. Press the white corner open and trim the seam allowance to ¼".
- Draw a diagonal line on the back of all the 1½" color squares. Match one 1½" color square to one corner of each white 3½" square and sew on the drawn line. Press toward the color and trim the seam allowance to ¼" Fig B.
- Lay the pieces of one color out as in Fig C. Sew the 2½" x 3½" color rectangle to the square unit Press away from the White. Sew that unit to the long rectangle. Press that seam open. Repeat for all four corners.
- Lay out the four Corner Units to match the Block at the top of the page. Sew and press the seams open. The unfinished block is 10½".



