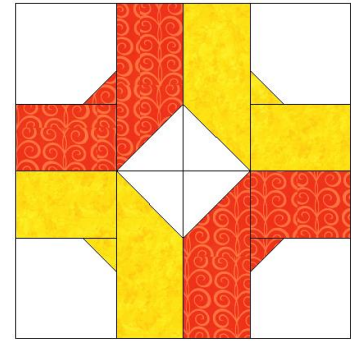


Some Like it Hot!

Colors – Pick two Colors for one block -
 Bright Hot Oranges, Reds or Yellows
 in a Tone on Tone, Print or Batik
 that read as one color.

Background – White on White Print or Solid.

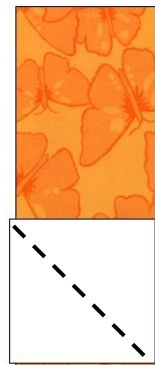


Cutting Instructions

From Color 1 and Color 2

- (2) 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" rectangles
- (2) 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles
- (2) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" square

Note: You can cut all the pieces for each color from 2 1/2" x 22" strips.

White – (4) 3 1/2" squares
 (4) 2 1/2" squares

1. Draw a diagonal line on the back of all the 2 1/2" white squares.
2. Match a 2 1/2" white square to the end of all four 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" color rectangles right sides together. Sew on the drawn lines in the same direction as in Fig A. Press the white corner open and trim the seam allowance to 1/4".
3. Draw a diagonal line on the back of all the 1 1/2" color squares. Match one 1 1/2" color square to one corner of each white 3 1/2" square and sew on the drawn line. Press toward the color and trim the seam allowance to 1/4" Fig B.
4. Lay the pieces of one color out as in Fig C. Sew the 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" color rectangle to the square unit – Press away from the White. Sew that unit to the long rectangle. Press that seam open. Repeat for all four corners.
5. Lay out the four Corner Units to match the Block at the top of the page. Sew and press the seams open. The unfinished block is 10 1/2".

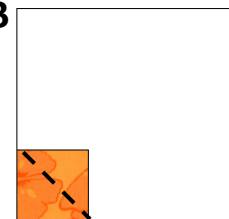
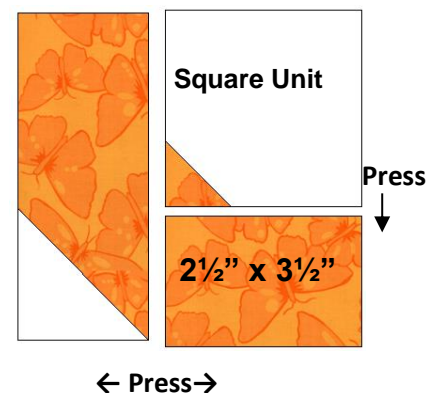
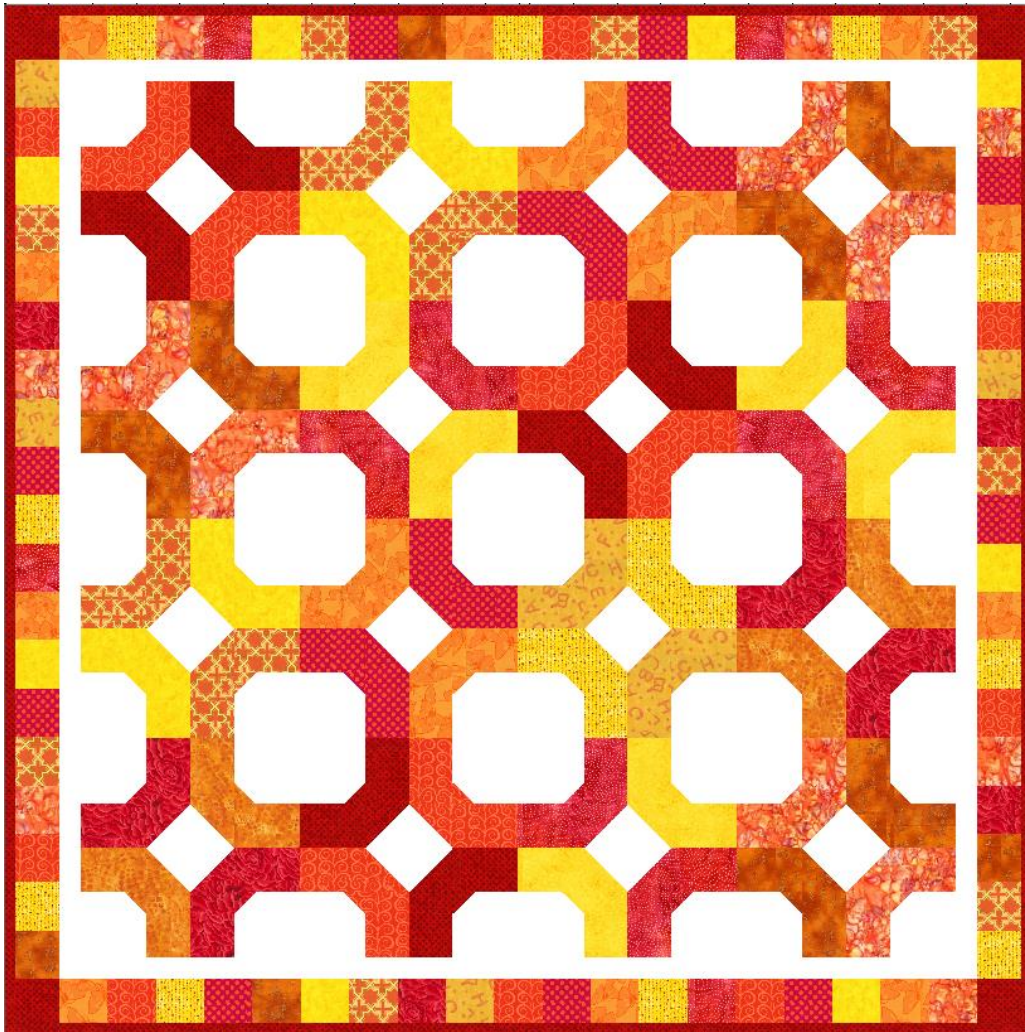
