

Winter Tree

Colors

Background - White on White or Light Silver snow-like fabrics. A little sparkle or metallic looks great.

Tree Branches - Medium to Dark Wintery Blues - w/wo sparkle

Trunk - Medium to Dark Gray or Brown



Cutting Instructions - 9 1/2" x 6 1/2" unfinished Block

Background

(6) 3 1/2" squares

(2) 2 1/2" x 3" rectangles

Tree Branches

(3) 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles

Tree Trunk

(1) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangle

- 1. Flying Geese Units** - Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of all the 3 1/2" background squares. Match a background square to one end of a 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" tree rectangle right sides together and sew on the drawn line **Fig 1**. Press toward the triangles and trim the seam allowance to 1/4". Match another square to the other end and sew on the drawn line **Fig 2**. Press toward the triangles and trim the seam allowance to 1/4". Make 2 more of these flying geese units.

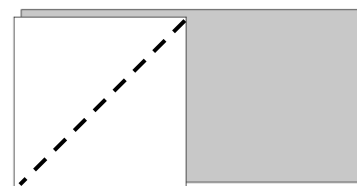

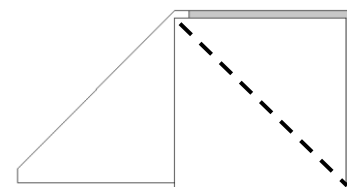
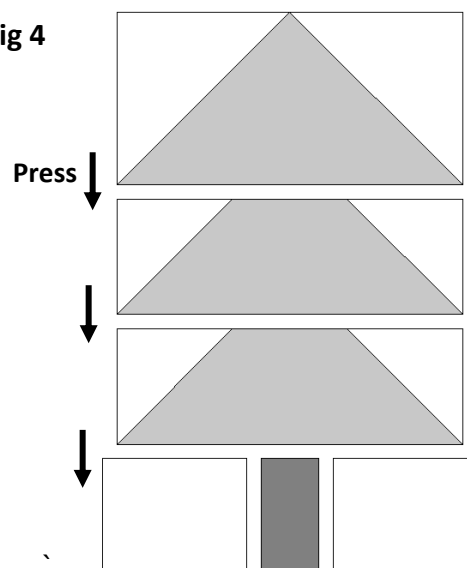

- 2. Making Branches** – Trim 1" off the top of **only 2** of the 3 flying geese units as in **Fig 3**. They now measure 6 1/2" x 2 1/2". Assemble the 3 branch sections like the diagram **Fig 4** and press all seams down..
- 3. Trunk** - Sew a 2 1/2" x 3" background Rectangle to either side of the trunk. and press toward the trunk **Fig 4**
- 4.** Sew trunk section to bottom of tree and press toward the trunk.
