Christmas Stocking

Colors_- Select 2 Fabrics in Christmas colors Reds, Greens, Golds or Wintery Blues that
you like together.

Background - White or White-on-White

Cutting Instructions for 1 Block

- **Stocking –** (1) 4½" x 6½" Rectangle *Main Color* (1) 2½" x 4½" Rectangle
 - (1) 21/2" square
- **Stocking –** (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Rectangle
 - **Trim Color** (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square
- **White –** (1) 2½" x 6½" Rectangle
 - **Background** (1) 2½" square
 - (2) 1½" squares
- 1. Sew the 2½" x 4½" Trim Color Rectangle to the Short side of the 4½" x 6½" Main Color Rectangle **Fig A.** Press toward the Trim.
- 2. Draw a diagonal line on the back of the White 2½" square and both White 1½" squares.
- 3. **Heel Unit** Match the 2½" White square to the Trim color 2½" square and stitch on the drawn line. Press to the color and trim the seam allowance to ½" **Fig B**.
 - Sew the Main Color $2\frac{1}{2}$ " sq to the half triangle as in **Fig C** and Press to the square.
- 4. **Toe Unit** Sew the 1½" White squares to the Corners of the 2½" x 4½" Main Color Rectangle as in **Fig D**. Press to the rectangle and trim the seam allowances to ¼".
- 5. Lay out all of the Units out as in Fig E.
- **6.** Sew the **Heel Unit** to the end of the 4½" x 6½" Main Rectangle. Press up to the Main Color.
- 7. Sew the Short side of the **Toe Unit** to the $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " White Rectangle and in **Fig E**. Press to the White.
- 8. Sew the Final vertical seam and Press away from the White. The unfinished block is 6½" x 10½".


